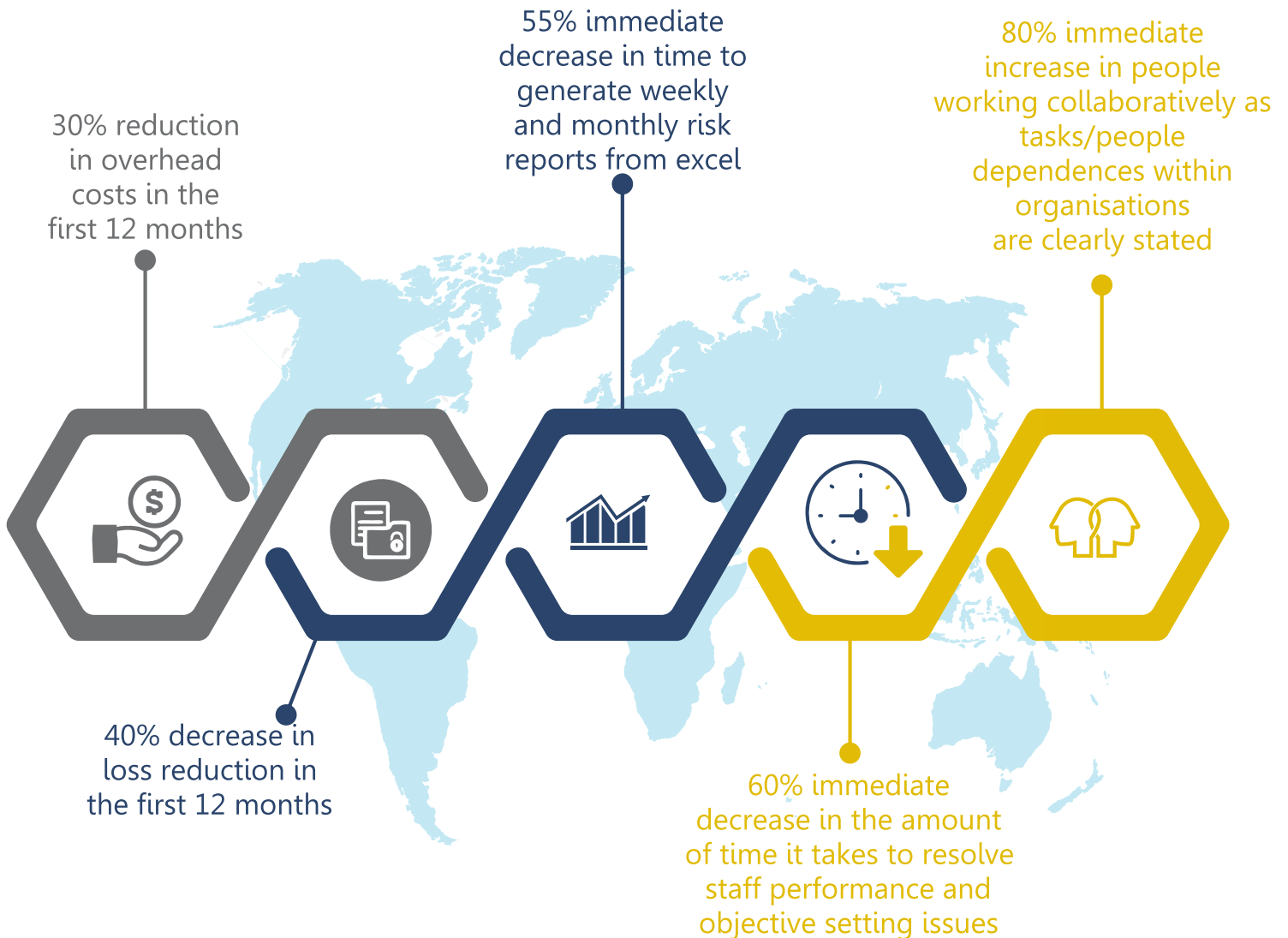

Welcome Address



Good morning all,

Your Excellency, the Vice President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, Prof Yemi Osinbajo, Nigerian National, State and Local Government Leaders and Officials, international public and private sector leaders, Conrad Clark Nigeria Partners and everyone participating in person or virtually.

I warmly welcome you all to this inaugural Public Sector Risk and Governance Summit, which is part of Conrad Clark's modest contribution aimed at supporting, strengthening and positioning the Nigerian public sector as one of the best and most effective in the post-Covid world.

For us at Conrad Clark, we see risk governance as the process of handling the effect of unplanned changes to or deviations from set goals, which could diminish performance outcomes. It aims to unveil ways of managing political leadership risks to foster accountability and boost investment, empower public administrators in handling exposure to social risks and other vulnerabilities, and hopefully inspire untapped sources of opportunities for the Nigerian people.

The PSRGS 2021 will stir up high-level dialogues among decisionmakers and other stakeholders on the best practices in delivering good risk governance and efficient public services to improve outcomes for citizens. Finally, we will be launching a simple guide to managing risk in the public sector next year, specifically at the end of the first quarter.

Once again, I hope this summit and our subsequent engagements with stakeholders will add value to the Nigerian public sector risk handling capacity.

Who we are:

Infrastructure Concession Regulatory Commission (ICRC) is an agency of the Federal Government of Nigeria responsible for the development and implementation of Public Private Partnership (PPP) framework for the provision of infrastructure services.

The ICRC was established under the Infrastructure Concession Regulatory Commission (Establishment, etc) Act 2005 to regulate PPP endeavours of the government aimed at addressing Nigeria's physical infrastructure deficit which hampers economic development.

Objective

To mobilize and accelerate private investments in national infrastructure by enabling the Federal Government of Nigeria through her Ministries, Departments, and Agencies (MDAs) to establish and implement effective Public Private Partnerships (PPPs).

Mandate

- Provide general policy guidelines, rules and regulations;
- Take custody of every concession agreement;
- Monitor and inspect PPP projects; and
- Ensure efficient execution of any concession agreement or contract entered into by the Federal Government.

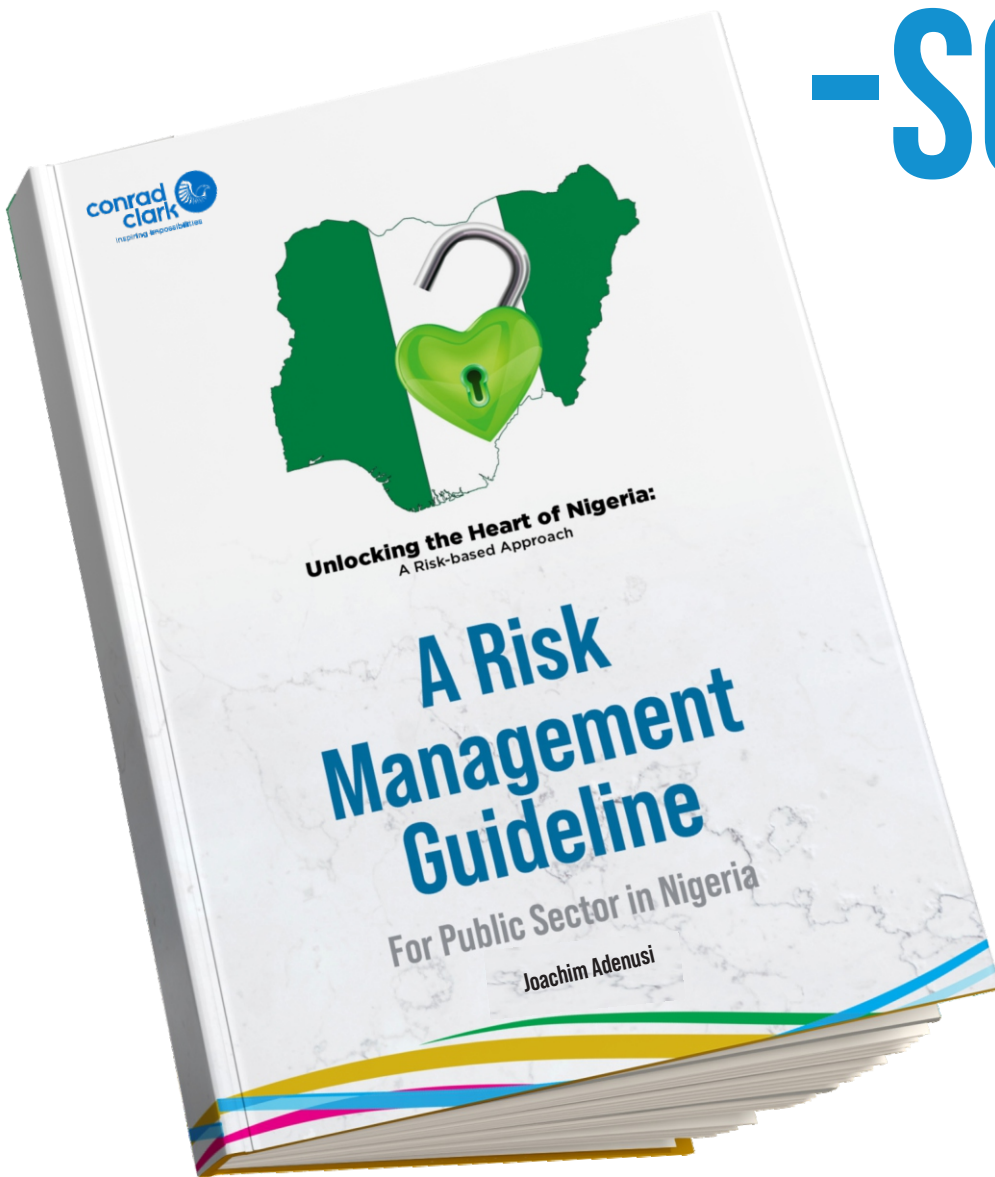
